According to the Cabinet Resolution, at its meeting on December 8, 2020, the National Reform Plan on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Version) was approved by defining reform activities (Big Rock). The reform activity number 5 to improve Thai Government to be transparency following by the first objective. All government agencies shall declare as an agency that does not accept gifts and gifts of any kind from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

This is to express the intention to strengthen morality, ethics, and transparency in the performance of their duties and operations under the principles of good governance of Watsongtham School. Therefore, the announcement is an agency that the management Civil servants, teachers, and all personnel. Do not accept gifts and gifts of any kind during, before, or after performing their duties. All Festivals (No Gift Policy) that may lead to discrimination or cause a conflict of interest unless it is necessary and cannot be avoided. Criteria for receiving gifts or gifts and any other benefits must be complied with in accordance with the Regulation of the Prime Minister's Office on Giving or Receiving of Government Officials, B.E. 2001) and with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission office B.E. 2020.

This announcement is hereby made known to all and must be strictly adhered to.
